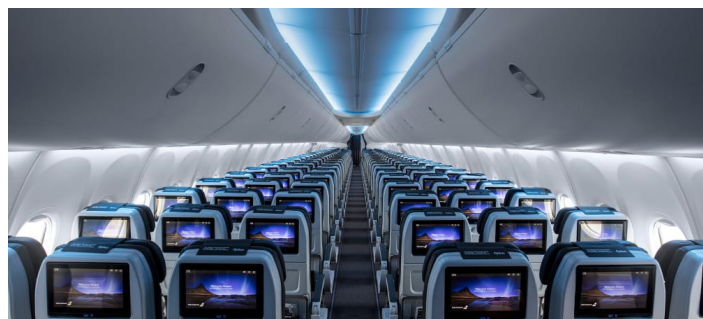

OUR FLEET

Icelandair has a flexible Boeing fleet, marrying commonality with varying sizes and capabilities. **Boeing 757s** service the US West Coast and Canada operations. **Boeing 767s** operate the high-density markets in Europe and the US East Coast. **Boeing 737 MAX 8** and **Boeing 737 MAX 9** are the latest additions to the fleet, and combine less fuel use, less noise and an innovative redesign of the aircraft cabin. **De Havilland Canada** aircraft operate the domestic and Greenland operations.
