All tickets are valid for 12 months. All tickets (except Economy Light) can be changed both before and after departure, subject to a fee.

Cabin: We offer comfortable leather seats, more legroom in all cabins and individual entertainment systems on all Icelandair flights.*

Meals: Food can be purchased in Economy Light, Standard and Flex. Meals are included in Saga Premium and for all children under 12. Non-alcoholic beverages are complimentary in Economy Class. It is possible to pre-order food in Economy class on our website or via GDS latest 24hours before departure. Group meals need to be pre-ordered via GDS up to 72 hours before departure.

Additional baggage: 20% discount applies when luggage including sport equipment is pre-booked up to 7 days (168 hours) until departure.

Therefore, the chances of catching these spectacular lights is greater during mid-winter, when the nights are long and dark.
