


## Build your own packages with Hotel Package Rates

Package rates are unpublished package and wholesale rates available to TAAP Agents. They offer an **average discount of 20% off** published rates. Hotel Package Rates should remain opaque and should not be disclosed at any time.

### Search for Hotel Package Rates

On your Expedia TAAP homepage, select 'Properties' and enter your search parameters. After reading and accepting the Package Rate Program Terms and Conditions, tick the box to confirm and 'Search for Package Rates'
